Full Sun Grass



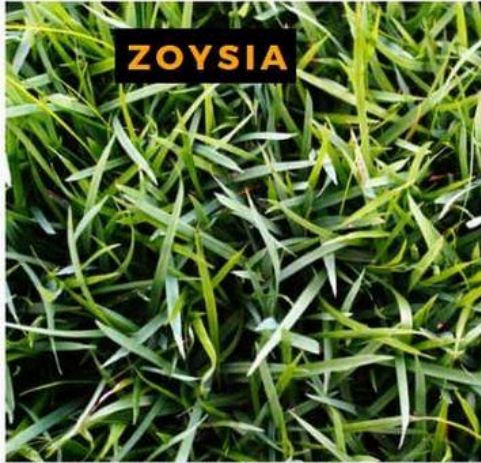
